International conference *Conflict Resolution and Interreligious Encounter* took place on 5-8 September, jointly organised by the Von Hügel Institute and the Wasatia Graduate School at the Europa-Universität Flensburg (EUF).

The conference served as a collaborative opportunity to examine questions of justice, reconciliation, political ethics, and interreligious dialogue, most especially those relevant to Jewish, Muslim, and Christian communities, focussing primarily on the use of scriptural reasoning as a dialogical training method to cultivate empathy across religious difference.

## 'Ethics of Care and Motherhood' Seminar Proposes New Evaluative Framework for Maternity Hospitals, Featuring 2023 Templeton Award Winner, Dr Edna Adan Ismail

VHI Research Associate <u>Dr Thana de Campos-Rudinsky</u> directed 'Ethics of Care and Motherhood: Towards a Public Policy' at the Pontificia Universidad Catolica de Chile. The seminar introduced a moral framework that evaluates hospitals based on the quality of care offered to mothers and newborns, using love and flourishing as indicators to rank institutions. Dr Edna Adan Ismail, midwife, activist, and winner of the 2023 Templeton Prize, delivered the keynote.

## Joint Guest Lecture Series with University of Notre Dame London Global Gateway, Michaelmas Term 2023

<u>Dr Andrew Skotnicki</u>, Professor of Religious Studies at Manhattan College, presented a lecture on 'Francisco Suárez, Criminal Injustice, and the Catholic Conception of Law'. Inspired by the intersection of his scholarly work in theological ethics and his decades-long experience teaching in American prisons, Skotnicki entered into lively conversation with new VHI Senior Research Associate <u>Dr Paolo Carozza</u> and VHI Research Associate <u>Mr Scott Jackson</u> regarding the nature and horizons of law in theory and in practice today.

New VHI Affiliate <u>Professor Michael Driessen</u>, Associate Professor of Political Science and International Affairs at John Cabot University, gave a guest lecture at St Edmund's College, drawing from his new book, *The Global Politics of Interreligious Dialogue: Religious Change, Citizenship and Solidarity in the Middle East* (Oxford University Press, 2023). In his lecture, Driessen presented the growth of statesponsored interreligious initiatives in the Middle East and their use as a policy instrument for engaging with religious communities and ideas.
